When you make the report, you can choose to identify yourself or remain anonymous. Your report will be shared with SEA leadership staff and the leadership of your member program.

We invite you to share concerns on any issues that relate to safety. Potential areas might include theft, violence, harassment, abuse, or a failure to follow established safety procedures, among others.
