### 2021 Summer Programs COVID-19 Policies

Mercersburg Summer Programs is committed to keeping its participants, its staff, and all members of the campus community safe and healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic. If individuals or groups are unable to follow these policies, they will lose the privilege of being an active participant within Mercersburg Summer Programs.

- We will recommend a 7- to 10-day quarantine before arrival on campus, unless the participant or staff is vaccinated.
- We will require a negative COVID-19 test within five days before arrival on campus.
- Summer Programs staff and participants will be required to wear a mask at all times except when showering, eating, in one's room, or when outside in sporting activities or socially distanced.
- Summer Programs staff and participants must follow the school's [One Mercersburg Promise](#) to support our community health and our goal of remaining on campus together.
- We will test participants and staff upon arrival. Additional testing if needed.

In addition to the above items, Mercersburg Summer Programs will have the following in place:

- Two participants per room in the dorms.
- A small dorm set aside for quarantine purposes (if needed).
- Programs divided into their own cohort groups.
- Hand sanitizer and cleaning stations throughout campus.
- Additional cleaning in common spaces.
- Signage reminding everyone of best COVID-19 health and safety practices.
- Limitations for bathroom/shower use so that only roommates are using them at the same time if not wearing masks.
- Grab-and-go meals from the dining hall (if needed).
- We will have tents for outdoor activities and eating (if needed).
