Summer Academy - Assistant Coach

The Squash and Education Alliance is seeking an experienced squash coach to work as an Assistant Coach for two weeks of intensive squash camp held at the Kent School this July 5-9 and July 11-15. The camp will bring together 32 SEA players ages 11-18 from SEA's network of 19 member organizations for two separate camp sessions, five days and four nights.

Responsibilities

Assistant Coaches will play a crucial role in helping ensure that the camp runs smoothly.

Responsibilities will include, but are not be limited to, the following areas:

- Collaborating with Squash Director in the planning of all squash, fitness, off court film analysis, and mental training sessions
- Coaching students on-court
- Leading and participating in fitness sessions and team-building activities
- Assisting in evening activities and competitions (with the support of four camp counselors)
- Supervising and engaging with students in the dorms, dining halls, classroom, on field trips, and during off-court evening activities, such as games and team-building activities
- Being ready and willing to do all tasks, big or small
- Adding positive enthusiasm and authenticity to help students enjoy their time, get to know one another, and maintain a positive attitude and strong work ethic

Additional responsibilities will include attending a one-day training immediately before the start of camp, assisting with student transportation to and from camp, and ensuring that the camp is a safe, supportive, and healthy experience for all participants.

Requirements & Qualifications

- Strong squash player with at least one year experience coaching
- College squash player or active squash coach preferred
- Willingness and ability to work long hours with a positive attitude
- Sets extremely high standards for self and has a strong work ethic
- Communicates clearly and professionally
- High energy, responsible, and open to direction from colleagues
- Proof of COVID vaccination is required

Location: Kent School in Kent, Connecticut

Compensation: \$2000 per week of availability

Lodging: Room, food, and transportation covered by SEA
