Summer Academy - Camp Counselor

The Squash and Education Alliance is seeking a team of counselors to coach, supervise, and lead students in an engaging two weeks of intensive squash at the Kent School this July 5-9 and July 11-15. The camp will bring together 32 SEA players ages 11-18 from SEA's network of 19 member organizations for two separate camp sessions, five days and four nights.

Responsibilities

Counselors play a critical role in helping ensure that the camp runs smoothly.

Responsibilities will include, but are not be limited to, the following areas:

- Coaching students on-court
- Leading and creating an environment of inclusivity and belonging for a group of 8 students
- Leading and participating in fitness sessions and team-building activities
- Supervising and engaging with students in the dorms, dining halls, classroom, on field trips, and during off-court evening activities, such as games and team competitions
- Being ready and willing to do all tasks, big or small
- Adding positive enthusiasm and authenticity to help students enjoy their time, get to know one another, and maintain a positive attitude and strong work ethic

Additional responsibilities will include attending a two-day training immediately before the start of camp, assisting with student transportation to and from camp, and ensuring that the camp is a safe, supportive, and healthy experience for all participants.

Requirements & Qualifications

- Must be over 18 years old
- Strong and well-established squash player and coach
- College squash player or active squash coach preferred
- Willingness and ability to work long hours with a positive attitude
- Sets extremely high standards for self and has a strong work ethic
- Communicates clearly and professionally
- High energy, responsible, and open to direction from colleagues
- Proof of COVID vaccination is required
