Summer Academy - Camp Counselor

The Squash and Education Alliance is seeking a team of counselors to coach, supervise, and lead students in an engaging two weeks of intensive squash camp held at the Kent School this July. The camp will bring together 32 of SEA's top junior players, from SEA's network of 20 member organizations. The camp consists of squash delivered alongside educational programming to provide a fun, engaging, and challenging environment on and off the squash court to inspire and empower students.

Responsibilities

Counselors play a critical role in helping ensure that the camp runs smoothly.

Responsibilities will include, but are not be limited to, the following areas:

- Coaching students on-court
- Leading and creating an environment of inclusivity and belonging for campers
- Checking rooms at wake-up and lights-out
- Leading and participating in fitness sessions and team-building activities
- Supervising and engaging with students in the dorms, dining halls, classroom, on field trips, and during off-court evening activities, such as games and team competitions
- Being ready and willing to do all tasks, big or small
- Assisting academic staff in classroom management and execution
- Adding positive enthusiasm and authenticity to help students enjoy their time, get to know one another, and maintain a positive attitude and strong work ethic.

Additional responsibilities will include attending a one-day training immediately before the start of camp, assisting with student transportation to and from camp, and ensuring that the camp is a safe, supportive, and healthy experience for all participants.

Requirements & Qualifications

- Must be 19 years old or older
- Strong and well-established squash player and coach
- College squash player or active squash coach preferred
- Willingness and ability to work long hours with a positive attitude
- Sets extremely high standards for self and has a strong work ethic
- Communicates clearly and professionally
- High energy, responsible, and open to direction from colleagues
